June 2007: Delivery of medicine to Rabia Balkhi and consultation as to their future requirements. We decided to purchase a cryogenic unit (this was the request of the Director) to use for treating pre-cancerous lesions. Training of staff was also planned.

July 2006: Delivery of new anesthesia machine to Rabia Balkhi Hospital			
April 2006: Delivery of U.S. medicine to Rabia Balkhi Hospital, Khair Khana Hospital and Dr. Roshak Warkak

October 2005: Delivery of blankets, heaters and medicine to Khair Khana Hospital			
August 2004: Delivery of medicines to Rabia Balkhi and Khair Khana Hospital
